The REID TECHNIQUE

Topics: The 'Reid' Technique of Interrogation: Often described as the 'Gold Standard' of police interrogation techniques. If carried out properly, the resulting confession can be a devastating piece of direct evidence for the Crown. If done properly, it can lead to false confessions and potentially gross miscarriages of justice.

The seminar will address *inter alia*, how to look for the tell-tale marks of a Reid interrogation, how to exploit systematic and practical weaknesses in relation to the statement of *voir dire* (either accused confession or KGB statement); and how to make the best of the situation if the statement is admitted into evidence.
