We can provide a record of observations collected during visits. There is a charge for this service; please speak to the Coordinator. Please note that a court report can only be released on consent of both parties, or by a court order.

Clients will be asked to sign a release of information form allowing us to speak with other professionals and the lawyers involved.

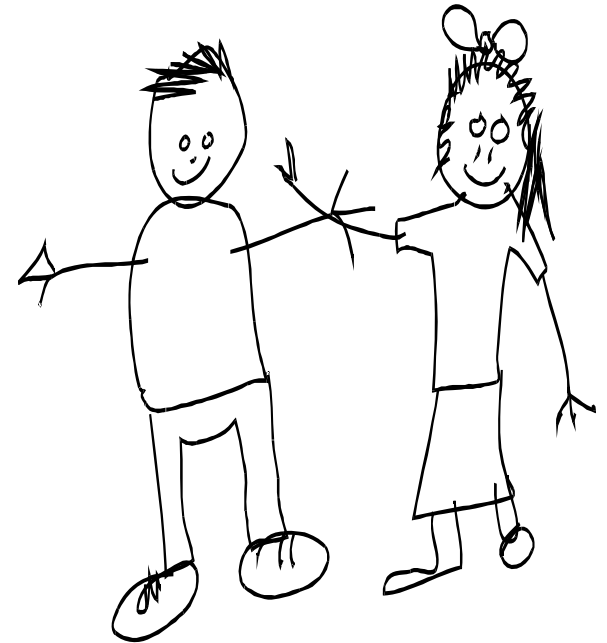

Program Description

The Peel Region Supervised Access Program in Ontario provides the opportunity for children to visit with their families on a consistent basis. We also provide a location for supervised drop-off and pick-up for children.

Program Objectives

To provide a safe, neutral environment for access to occur.

To help children and their families through difficult periods of separation and adjustment.

To provide a setting where visits and exchanges can occur under the supervision of trained staff and volunteers.

SERVICES

- ❑ Fully supervised access on premises (enclosed playground available)
- ❑ Supervised transfer of children for day or weekend visits off premises

FEES

An annual non-refundable administration fee of \$50.00 each and a \$25.00 fee for each visit/exchange applies.

HOW TO MAKE A REFERRAL

To make a referral, you need to contact the Program Coordinator to discuss the suitability of your referral before sending correspondence.

When corresponding, please include the following:

- ❑ A copy of the Court Order or a Letter of Agreement which specifies the conditions of access (i.e. times, dates, who shall attend visits, restrictions, etc.)
- ❑ Copies of affidavits (from court files and from both parents) in relation to the access, any social work assessments and/or psychiatric reports involving either parent
- ❑ A written referral with full names, addresses and phone numbers of both parents & lawyers and full name & date of birth of child(ren) involved.

It is important to forward all pertinent information as soon as possible. If a program space is not available, your client will be placed on a waiting list and contacted as soon as space is available

Each parent must attend an intake interview with the Coordinator before access may begin
